Memo: Face-Covering Exemption Letter Required

Fall 2020 Students,

It is our greatest privilege to offer an exceptional experience while you are here on our campus. We go through great efforts to provide a variety of opportunities for you to grow in faith, knowledge, and service each semester. Part of this effort is providing an environment for training that is as safe as we can reasonably make it. While our dependence is ultimately on the Lord for the safety of our staff and student bodies, it is our responsibility as leaders and teachers to make wise choices in managing this facility and its residents.

As many of you are aware, on July 30, 2020, the Governor of Wisconsin issued Emergency Order #1, which requires that all residents of the State wear a face-covering in enclosed spaces. As such, students will need to wear a face-covering while indoors except for private apartments or living areas.

If you are requesting an exemption due to a medical condition, it will be necessary for you to provide a letter from your treating physician explaining why you need an exemption. This letter is necessary to allow our office to evaluate your request for an exemption from the Governor's Order. Any information provided will be protected by the same confidentiality requirements as other medical records in a student's personnel file.

We thank you in advance for your understanding as we embark on a new academic year during these challenging times.
